In 2008 SAM once again entered two engines in the Engine Masters Challenge. The first was our updated 400 Chevrolet from 2007 and the other a 400 Ford. Thanks to Hurricane Ike we had to finish up our engines powering the shop with generators. Ike caused some problems with the shipping companies in this region and caused the Chevy to be delayed and unable to make it by the deadline. So, with only one engine eligible SAM focused on the 400 Ford that did make it there.

Team SAM had the 400 Ford running strong qualifying 3rd overall going into Fridays Final Eliminations. Making a peak of 675 hp and 620 lb/ft of torque and with a final score of 2502.8 Team SAM finished the challenge in fourth place overall. Making it the third straight year that SAM has made it to the finals in this highly competitive Engine Masters Challenge.
